Objectives

Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant (HMEP): To increase State, local, territorial and Native American tribal effectiveness to safely and efficiently handle hazardous materials accidents and incidents; enhance implementation of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986 (EPCRA); and encourage a comprehensive approach to emergency planning and training by incorporating response to transportation standards. Hazardous Materials Instructor Training Grant (HMIT): To "train the trainer" – that is, to train hazmat instructors who will then train hazmat employees in the proper handling of hazardous materials. Supplemental Public Sector Training Grants (SPST): to increase the number of hazardous materials training instructors, thereby increasing the number of training instructors available to conduct hazardous materials responder training programs for individuals with statutory responsibility to respond to hazardous materials accidents and incidents.

West Virginia State Emergency Response Commission

WV Code §15-5A-1 West Virginia State Emergency Response Commission - The State Emergency Response Commission shall have within its jurisdiction and supervision the preparation and implementation of comprehensive emergency response plans for each designated emergency planning district within the state so as to comply with the requirements of 42 U.S.C. §11001, et seq. The commission, through the office of emergency services, shall also be responsible for providing the citizens of this state with information in accordance with the requirements of 42 U.S.C. §11001, et seq. and this article. All state agencies shall cooperate with and assist the commission in all commission duties and responsibilities.

Tier II Fees §55-1-9: All fees collected shall be deposited into a subaccount of the SERC and may only be used for purposes authorized by W.Va. Code §15-5A-1

LEPC Grants §55-1-10: The purpose of this procedure is to implement the emergency planning program grants as authorized by W.Va. Code §15-5A-5(k) LEPC Grants are based on the amount of Tier II fees collected by the WV SERC.

U.S. DOT Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning Grant CFDA 20.703(HMEP): HMEP Grants are designed to develop and provide education and training to public sector employees for the purpose of responding to chemical accidents/incidents in accordance with OSHA 1910.120 The Grant is broken into training and planning. LEPC's that qualify receive money to assist in the emergency response planning and exercises associated with hazardous materials transportation incidents.

WV SERC has an MOU with the West Virginia Department of Education/RESA's to provide hazmat training to the LEPC's and first responders through the HMEP Training Grant
