
Overview of the Community Rating System





CRS Basics

- ✓ Part of the National Flood Insurance Program
 - Administered by FEMA
- ✓ Provides reduced flood insurance premiums where there is better floodplain management
- ✓ Administered by Insurance Services Office
 - ➤ ISO/CRS Specialist

- Reduce and avoid flood damage to insurable property
- Strengthen and support insurance aspects of the NFIP
- Foster comprehensive floodplain management











The CRS in West Virginia

Prerequisites to Participate

- In Regular Phase of NFIP ≥ 1 year
- 2. In full compliance with NFIP minimum criteria
- 3. Agree to maintain Elevation Certificates
- 4. Assess and address repetitive loss properties
- Maintain all flood insurance policies required for community-owned buildings
- Coastal communities agree to show LiMWA on FIRM


