A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor

WHEREAS, on the ninth day of January, Two Thousand Fourteen, water supplied by West Virginia American Water Company became contaminated, and in accordance with my authority as Governor, I declared a State of Emergency in Boone, Jackson, Kanawha, Lincoln, and Putnam Counties, West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, according to West Virginia American Water Company, the circumstances at issue in the State of Emergency may also exist in Cabell, Clay, Logan, and Roane Counties; and

WHEREAS, in addition, West Virginia American Water Company advises that the water supplies of the City of Culloden, the City of Hurricane, the Lincoln Public Service District, the Queen Shoals Public Service District, and the Reamer Hill Public Service District may be affected by the circumstances at issue in the State of the Emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EARL RAY TOMBLIN, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, and in view of the foregoing, do hereby FIND AND DECLARE that the State of Emergency previously proclaimed on this day extends to Cabell, Clay, Logan, and Roane Counties, West Virginia, and said State of Emergency shall remain in effect until rescinded by further Proclamation.
